

Session Five – Origami Boat

For this Craft you will need:

Pop Box Craft Sheet 5

Scissors

Pens or pencils

In the sections in between the brown and the colours, you can write a prayer to God.

Once you've written your prayer, or thankyou to God, we can start folding. To help with the folding later, start by folding along all the lines so you can see the lines on both sides, this doesn't matter what order you do them in.

Once you have made a crease down all the lines, start by folding the template in half. Make sure the coloured sides are facing each other.


Next, take one of the corners down to the centre line using the creases we created earlier and repeat on the other side. You should have a triangle with a long rectangle at the bottom.

Then, the rectangle at the bottom, fold that up over the triangle. Turn the whole thing over and repeat. Tuck in the corners to create one big triangle.

Now, facing the points downwards towards the ground, put your fingers on either side and push it together, opening up the triangle to create a square.

Place the square down with the V shape facing towards you.

Take the bottom corner to the top corner and crease, then turn the whole thing over and repeat.



You should now have a smaller triangle. You should be able to see the colours and prayers now.

And now we can repeat what we did earlier. Make sure the point of the triangle is facing downwards, then we're going to use our fingers to push the sides together so, you can see the inside. Push it together, and we've made another square.

Lay the square down with the coloured sections facing away from you.

Take the bottom corner to the top corner, and fold it along the middle. Turn the whole thing over and repeat. Push down really hard to make sure you've made a good fold line.

Now facing the point towards the ground again, push the two sides together to make a really small square, you should be able to see the colours poking out the top.

Now this bit is the really tricky bit. Grab the two outside brown bits, and pull them out a bit.

Really carefully and slowly pull them out and you will begin to see the boat take shape. Once you have this shape, you can then push it down to create the fold lines at the bottom.

And there you have it your own little paper boat! And you should be able to see your prayer or thank you to God on the inside.
